### Registration Fees

Hockey School (approximately 15 hours of ice time) all children from 3 to 6 years old :	\$160 + \$40 (tickets) = \$200.00
Initiation	\$305 + \$120 (3 booklet of tickets) = \$425.00
Novice to PeeWee	\$405 + \$120 (3 booklet of tickets) = \$525.00
Bantam and Midget	\$480 + \$120 (3 booklet of tickets) = \$600.00
Juvenile	\$425.00

**A late fee of \$50.00 will be applied for registration made after June 1, 2010.**

### Multifamily Savings from Initiation to Juvenile Levels

- No rebates for Hockey School players.
- For players in the Initiation level (2 or more players in the same level, the 2nd players pays \$255.00 for registration and \$120.00 for tickets (3 booklets) = \$375.00
- First child (oldest) full cost
- Second child reduction of \$50.00 off registration fee
- Third and subsequent children reduction off of registration fee of \$100.00

Payment in **full at the time of registration** must be made in order for the player to participate. We offer these payment options:

1. Full payment at registration
2. Payment in 2 cheques dated September 15th and November 15th.
3. Payment in 3 cheques dated September 15th, October 15th and November 15th.

Pro-rated refunds will only be issued before December 1, 2010. No refunds will be issued after this date.

### Coaches, Trainers and Referees

ODMHA's regulations require coaching Level I and II for coaches at Nation level and a Level III is required for coaching P.G.L. level. Trainers must have a Level I qualification for all categories.
